## IIWCC OVERVIEW

The International Interprofessional Wound Care Course (IIWCC) is designed for wound care specialists with some wound care education and experience: physicians, nurses, and other health professionals in the wound care field related industry.

The IIWCC is a 12-month course, offered in partnership with the University of Toronto. The objective is to provide a comprehensive educational experience for wound care specialists and to translate new knowledge into practice.

- **Two mandatory residential weekends (4 days each)**
- **Fourteen self-study modules (9 required to complete 5 faculty chosen and 4 student chosen)**
- **A selective related to course content translated to class members with written report that is translated to each student's day- to- day activities.**
